Four-week Language Institute Professional Writing Series

Participants coming for the four-week Language Institute will experience a combination of advanced grammar and writing review with a focused study in the area of professional writing. Participants will come on a F1 visa for the full-time program, enroll as K-State students and enjoy all of the privileges of student services and activities.



Advanced Integrated Skills This course provides participants the support needed to be successful in the professional writing. The course will focus on a review of advanced grammar especially with applications in professional and academic writing. In addition, participants will explore methods to enhance their writing style with an eye to improving the level of writing and vocabulary usage. Participants will learn to proofread and edit their own writing with the aim of becoming more independent writers.

Professional Writing In this course, participants will produce one 12-15 page research paper related to their field of study. Participants will receive a solid background in accessing and utilizing resources (e.g. online journals, databases, etc.) in an academic library, using these resources to produce a fully-developed, scholarly paper, and understanding the expectations of academic work regarding plagiarism in American universities and how to avoid it. In addition, participants will receive continued support in the areas of writing and grammar.

The Tutoring Center will provide support to participants in editing their current work.
